2011 Metropolitan COSAFA Under-20 Youth Championships

FIFA LEADS COACHING COURSE

There will be a significant boost for coaches involved in Under-20 football in the COSAFA region after it was announced that a FIFA-led coach's course will be held in Botswana next month.

FIFA, together with COSAFA, have arranged the course in Gaborone, Botswana, from November 13-19.

It will be held ahead of the 2011 Metropolitan COSAFA Under-20 Youth Championships that will once again be held in Botswana from December 1-10, following the huge success of the tournament in that country last year.

The coach's course will be run by FIFA Instructors Roy Miller from UEFA and Sonnyboy Sethibe of Botswana, together with COSAFA representative Baba Malephane from Lesotho.

One of the main aims of the course is to help local coaches from the region get to grips with the changes in the game that have come in over the last decade.

Football is an ever-evolving sport and the principles of coaching, while largely the same as a decade ago, have changed slightly too in the eyes of FIFA.
